INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND POLICY

The Fund promotes ESG characteristics pursuant to article 8 of the SFDR. The Fund seeks to maximize return in line with money market rates and to preserve the value of the investment ensuring its underlying assets can easily be bought or sold in the market.

The objective of the Fund is to provide a level of day-to-day liquidity, preserve the invested capital while producing the best possible money market return for the investor and to outperform its benchmark/reference index, minus fees. To achieve that objective, the Fund intends to invest only in instruments paying lower yields but being relatively safe on the short term. The Fund may also use eligible financial derivative instruments.

Eligible securities are identified based on a proprietary responsible investment process and the Investment Manager will simultaneously be applying Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) criteria process on an ongoing basis to select securities covering at least 70% of the Fund's portfolio on an ongoing basis and provided that the issuers follow good corporate governance practices.
